Jeffries of the County and State aforesaid merchants and partners trading under the Firm and Style of Camp and Jeffries of the first part all at their Consent of the County and State aforesaid of the second part and Zebulon Simmons of the County of Northampton and State of Virginia of the third part Witnesseth that the said Zebulon Simmons having become the security of said J. O. Camp in a Bond executed to the Commissioners named in a decree of Northampton County Court sitting in Chambers for the purchase of a slave named Shool sold by said Commissioners and purchased by said John O. Camp which negro was sold by said Camp and the money arising from said sale was applied to the partnership firm action of said Camp and Jeffries and the said Camp and Jeffries being anxious to secure the said Simmons from any possible injury in said security ship and for and in the further consideration of one dollar to them in hand paid by the said Consent at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and delivered and by these presents doth grant bargain sell & deliver unto the said all at their Consent all the goods wares and merchandise which a certain William P. Williams now in the employ of said Camp & Jeffries has in his possession and the said Camp and Jeffries do agree the said goods wares and merchandise now in possession of said Williams and hereby conveyed are all or at more than five hundred dollars also a gray horse and wagon now in possession of Williams the Pedlar. To have and to hold the said goods and horse and wagon to the said all at their Consent his heirs Executors and administrators against the claim of whom the said J. O. Camp and R. M. Jeffries their heirs or the claim or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever upon Trust nevertheless that the said all at their Consent shall when required by the said Simmons after giving legal notice of the time and place of sale proceed to sell the property above conveyed for cash and after paying the debt for which the said Simmons is security for said Camp as aforesaid and the Cost of the said return pay over the balance if any to said Camp and Jeffries full Worth of which the parties have hereunto set their hands and seals this day and date above written
