This Indenture made and executed this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of February A.D. one thousand eight hundred and thirty one between Simon Murfee and Lydia his wife of the first part and then son James W. Murfee of the second part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesses that whereas the said Simon Murfee and Lydia his wife have for and in consideration of the natural love and affection that they have for their son James W. Murfee given and granted granted and confirmed unto the said James W. Murfee his heirs and assigns forever 100 acres of the tract and parcel of land on which they now reside at being writing Land lying on the Southeastern part adjoining the Cooper tract and further they have for and in consideration of Eleven hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said James W. Murfee the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged bargained and sold alienated and confirmed unto the said James W. Murfee his heirs and assigns forever all the balance of the tract and parcel of Land on which they now live making the whole number of acres given away and sold the said James W. Murfee his heirs and assigns 258 1/2 acres which includes the tract and parcel of Land the said Simon Murfee derived from his father the parcel which he bought from Abraham L. Gardner the parcel which he bought from Matthew Wells and the two parcels which he bought of John Wells and is bounded as follows Beginning at a white oak near the road thence up the road a line between Abraham L. Gardner and this tract to a red oak in Elias Edwards line thence along the line between Elias Edwards and this tract to Wells Murfee's line thence down the Edge of the Approp. Swamp to a red oak bush thence across the Approp. Swamp to a red oak a corner between this tract and the John Wells tract in a line of Capt. Edwards which was James Edwards thence along a line of marked trees between this tract and the John Wells tract to a large Water oak a corner between this tract and the John Wells tract thence along a line of marked trees a line between this tract and William E.
