negro girl mimo one negro girl Harriet one negro girl Sunny at any time or
times required by the said Es on his heirs executors or assigns for the best price
that can be obtained for the said property above mentioned but of such
sale ten days previous and public notice shall be given by an advertisement and
with the proceeds of such sale first pay unto the said Es on his heirs executors
the sum aforesaid or as much thereof as may be due with interest and all
costs and charges which may attend the said sale and then pay the surplus of
