This Indenture made this day of April 1831 Between John Richardson of the  
County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part John R Williams  
of the second and Edmund Underwood of the third part Whereas the said John  
Richardson is justly indebted to Bailey Bryant and Edmund Underwood security  
in the sum of forty eight dollars and 96 cents bearing date about the ~~next~~ and the  
said John Richardson being willing and desirous to secure the payment of the same  
aforesaid Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and  
also for the sum of one dollar in hand paid by John R Williams at and before the  
sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
the said John Richardson hath given granted bargained sold and delivered  
the following property viz 4 Beds and Furniture one desk one chest six chairs  
and two buffets or Cupboards unto the said John R Williams his heirs & executors  
and the said John Richardson for himself his heirs & executors hereby remand and agree  
with him the said John R Williams his heirs & executors in manner and form  
following that is to say that the said John Richardson his heirs & executors  
for property hereby conveyed unto the said John R Williams his heirs & executors against all  
persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents  
upon Trust Neverthelss that the said John R Williams his heirs & executors shall per  
mit the said John Richardson his heirs & executors to remain in quiet possession of the aforesaid  
property hereby conveyed and take the profits thereof to his own use and behoof  
until default be made in the aforesaid debt of forty eight dollars and 96 Cents  
in part or in the whole and then upon the further trust that so soon as default  
be made upon the payment of such debt the said John R Williams his heirs & executors  
at the request of him the said Edmund Underwood his heirs & executors the aforesaid  
property to publish sale after giving legal notice and out of the proceeds of such  
sale pay the aforesaid sum of forty eight dollars and ninety six cents with interest  
and cost and the surplus money if any pay to him the said John Richardson  
his heirs & executors but if the whole of the aforesaid debt interest and costs be discharged  
to the satisfaction of him the said Edmund Underwood his heirs & executors on or before the first  
day of December next then this Indenture is to be void otherwise to remain in full
