This Indenture made this 30th day of December one thousand eight hundred and thirty, Between John Womack and wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Thomas Hathcock of the said County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said John Womack and Elizabeth his wife in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars lawful money of this State to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Hathcock or second to be paid at or before the ensuing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof both acknowledge hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth sell of their Right and sell unto the said Thomas Hathcock his heirs and assigns two certain tracts or parcels of Land lying and being in the County and State aforesaid one on the back side of Flat Swamp adjoining the lands of William Drury's Orphans and Aaron Worrell containing twenty six acres. One tract on the front side of flat swamp bounded by the lands of Willie Francis containing thirty six acres making in the whole forty two acres to the same more or less with all the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Thomas Hathcock to have and to hold the said tract of Land with the aforesaid privileges unto Thomas Hathcock his heirs and assigns forever and the said John Womack and Elizabeth his wife doth warrant and give over unto the right and title of the said lands unto the said Thomas Hathcock his heirs and assigns forever in witness whereof the said John Womack and Elizabeth his wife have hereunto set their hand and seals this day and date above written
