This Indenture made this 23rd day of April 1831 between Edwards Butts of the first part Drury Waller of the second part and John C. Turner of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia: Whereas the said John C. Turner on the 16th day of July 1827 in order to secure the payment of the sum of five hundred and ninety five dollars and seventy five cents to the said Drury Waller, did by indenture of Trust of that date convey to the said Edwards Butts his heirs Executors and administrators the following property to wit: One negro man Jm. one negro woman Silky and child Dicto one negro woman Kate and child Fortin upon Trust for the uses and purposes in the said Indenture mentioned: And whereas since the executing and delivering of the said Deed of Trust the said John C. Turner hath fully satisfied and paid to the said Drury Waller the sum of money thereby secured which the said Drury Waller doth hereby acknowledge: Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for the considerations aforesaid as well as for the further Consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said John C. Turner to the said Edwards Butts at and before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Edwards Butts with the assent and approbation of the said Drury Waller signified by his being party to these presents and the said Drury Waller have granted bargain and sold remised released and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain and sell remise release and confirm unto the said John C. Turner all the estate right title interest claim and demand both at Law and in Equity which the said Edwards Butts and Drury Waller have or hold in the Slaves above mentioned To have and to hold the aforesaid Slaves to him the said John C. Turner his heirs Executors and administrators forever to the only proper use and behoof of the said John C. Turner his heirs Executors adms and assigns forever: And the said Edwards Butts and Drury Waller for themselves their heirs Executors and the above mentioned Slaves unto the said John C. Turner his heirs Executors and assigns in as full and ample manner as the same were warranted by the said John C. Turner by the Deed of Trust above recited do warrant the same to the said John C. Turner against or claims of them the said Edwards Butts and Drury Waller and all persons claiming by or under them or either of them In Witness whereof the parties to these presents have hereunto set their hand and affixed their seals the day and year above written signed sealed and acknowledged
