This Indenture made and extended into the 11th day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty one between Jeremiah Stephenson of the first part and Willm Stephenson of the second part and Jonathan Puter of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said Jeremiah Stephenson for and in Consideration of the sum of thirty dollars which said sum is due from the said Jeremiah Stephenson to the said Jonathan Puter by Bond bearing date the 22nd day of March one thousand eight hundred and thirty one as well as all other monies which may be due and owing from the said Jeremiah Stephenson to the said Jonathan Puter by means of any dealing transfer of debts or papers whatever as also for and in Consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Willm Stephenson the receipt whereof the said Jeremiah Stephenson doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth hereby grant bargain and sell convey and make over unto the said Willm Stephenson and his heirs forever all his right and interest in the following property to wit one Acre and wharf one bay mowed feather Beds 4 Sheds 2 Chest 3 painted tables 1 gown 1 set of Chairs 1 dog 1 plough trace do. 5 Acre of Blade fodder 1 Corn one safe 1 Cow 3 iron pots 1 spider one oven 1 frying pan 1 plough huss & Cutter belonging to him the said Jeremiah Stephenson To Have and to Hold with all the right and interest of the said Jeremiah Stephenson herein conveyed or intended to be conveyed to him the said Willm Stephenson his heirs and assigns forever upon this Special Trust nevertheless that the said Willm Stephenson upon being thus so required by the after said Jonathan Puter shall proceed to sell all the right and interest of the said Jeremiah Stephenson to the above named property hereby conveyed or intended to be conveyed after advertising the time and place in the said County of Southampton for ten days previous at some public house or store for cash and out of the money arising out of the said Sale in the first place pay and satisfy all cost attending the said Sale as well as the expense attending the said conveyance and then pay off the Bond aforesaid with interest as well as all other monies which may appear to be due and owing from the said Jeremiah Stephenson to the said Jonathan Puter by means of any dealings transfer of debts or papers whatever and the surplus if any pay to the said Jeremiah Stephenson And the said Jeremiah Stephenson for himself his heirs executors and administrators the right and title of the said property herein conveyed unto the said Willm Stephenson his heirs and assigns forever doth hereby warrant and defend against the lawful claim of him the said Jeremiah Stephenson his heirs executors and assigns and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever and the said Willm Stephenson on his part warrants and agrees that he will make
