heirs Executors and assigns forever in manner and form following that is
to say that the said Amos Barrow his heirs Executors the aforesaid neg-
ro woman Betty and her future increase hereby conveyed unto the said Sife Drury
his heirs Executors and assigns against all persons whatsoever shall and will warrant
and forever defend by these presents. Upon Trust nevertheless that the said
Sife Drury his heirs Executors and assigns shall permit the said Amos Barrow
to remain in quiet possession of the said negro woman Betty until default be
made in the payment of the sum of one hundred and ten dollars and then
upon this further Trust he the said Sife Drury his heirs Executors and assigns
shall and will do soon after the happening of such default of payment may
think proper or he the said Edwards Butler his heirs Executors and assigns shall
request sell the said negro woman Betty and her increase to the highest bidder
for cash after giving at least ten days notice of the time and place of sale out
of the money arising from such sale pay and satisfy all costs and expenses
attending such sale then the debt and interest that may grow due thereon
and the balance of such sale pay over to the said Amos Barrow his heirs
Executors or such person or persons as he may authorize to receive the
