This Indenture made and entered into this 25th day of October one thousand Eight hundred and thirty between Enos Drury and Mary Drury his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Stuart Drury of the County and State of Virginia of the other part. Witnesseth that whereas the said Enos Drury and Mary his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Ten dollars lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Stuart Drury at or before this date and delivery of these presents this receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged that he the said Enos Drury and Mary his wife have bargained sold aliened conveyed and confirmed unto the said Stuart Drury all the interest appertaining unto the said Enos Drury and Mary his wife in a parcel or tract of Land lying and being in the County and State aforesaid containing by estimation thirty rods and be the same more or less of which the said Enos Drury and his wife Mary is entitled to one sixth part it being known by the Land of Henry Johnson dec'd and bounded as follows By the land of Humphrey Drury and well known as follows To have and to hold this said bargained tract or parcels of Land with all and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging unto the said Enos Drury and Mary his wife unto the said Stuart Drury his heirs Executors and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Stuart Drury his heirs Executors and assigns and he the said Enos Drury and Mary his wife doth warrant and forever defend his interest in the tract or parcel of Land against all and every other person or persons whatsoever.
