Williams in consideration of sum of two hundred and fifty dollars lawful money of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said Nicholas H. Williams at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Nicholas H. Williams his heirs or assigns forever all that his moiety of an undivided part of Land descended to me by my father Stephen Williams well containing by estimation two hundred and twenty five be the same more or less bounded as follows to wit on East by John Davis land on the North by land of Edwin Dickis heirs and west by Robert G. Simmons land South by Robert Rocks & Land with all the appurtenances situated lying and being in the County of Southampton To Have and to hold the said Land with the tenements and all the singular other premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every right members and appurtenances unto the said Nicholas H. Williams his heirs or assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Nicholas H. Williams his heirs and assigns forever and the said John H. Williams for himself &c. with all the singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Nicholas H. Williams his heirs or assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said John H. Williams or his heirs &c. of all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall will and do warrant and forever defend by these presents. In Testimony whereof the said John H.
