This Indenture made and entered into this 17 day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty one between William L. Ewitt of the first part and Edwards Wills of the second part, James Rochelle Alexander P. Fife Joseph T. Alcock Wm H. Ewitt Benjamin Carter Ewitt and Indiana M. Ewitt of the third part, whereas the said William L. Ewitt is indebted for the sum of thirteen hundred dollars or thereabouts which was paid over to him by the above named Joseph T. Alcock as the of Allen Jones dec^d on account of his wife Rebecca's proportion of the said Jones' estate and which with his other property by marriage articles date on the 4 day of January 1826 was conveyed to the ~~above~~ named James Rochelle as Trustee subject to the uses and trusts in the said marriage ^{articles} contract specified which will more fully appear by reference to them of record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County Court and which money is as laid out in the purchase of the tract of land herein after mentioned and which payment was made on the 29 day of January 1826 and whereas the said William L. Ewitt is also indebted to his two children Wm H. and Benjamin Carter in the sum of two hundred and twenty five dollars with interest thereon from the 31st day of November 1827 for so much money received by him for a negro woman named Rebecca and her child belonging to them and by him sold and the price received and also in the further sum of three hundred and fifteen dollars with interest thereon from the 1st day of August in the year 1827 which arose from the sales of the land of Thomas S. Fikes dec^d and which they indebted from their deceased mother as her proportion thereof and whereas he is also indebted to the said Indiana M. Ewitt in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars with interest from the 25th day of October 1827 at being the price of his negro girl named Lucy then sold by him and the money received and whereas he is also indebted to the said James Rochelle in the sum of forty two dollars and ninety eight cents due by bond dated the 6 day of December 1827 and payable on demand and the said James Rochelle is bound as his duty is a Bond due and payable to Rich R. Foy and Company for one hundred and six dollars and No date on the 21 day of June 1830 with a Credit endorsed for forty dollars paid the
