This Indenture made and entered into this 17th day of May in the year of our Lord one
thousand Eight hundred and thirty one between William L. Evans of the first part and
Edwards Butts of the second part. James Rockelle Alexander P. T. Stiles Joseph S. Edwards
Wm. M. Evans Benjamin Carter Evans and Indiana M. I. Evans of the third part
whereas the said William L. Evans is indebted for the sum of thirteen hundred dollars
or thereabouts which was paid over to him by the above named Joseph S. Edwards and
of Allen Jones dec'd on account of his wife Rebecca T. & proportion of the said Jones
estate and which with his other property by marriage accrued sets on the 1st day of
January 1826 was conveyed to the ~~three~~ ^{other} names. James Rockelle as trustee subject
to the uses and trust in the said marriage ~~trust~~ ^{estate} specified - which will more
fully appear by reference to them of record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton
County Court and which money was laid out in the purchase of the tract of land
herein after mentioned and which payment was made on the 2nd day of January
1826 and whereas the said William L. Evans is also indebted to his two children
Wm. M. and Benjamin Carter in the sum of two hundred and eighty five dollars with
interest thereon from the 21st day of November 1837 for so much money received by him
for a negro woman named Rubina and her child belonging to them and by himself
and the said received and also in the further sum of three hundred and fifteen
dollars with interest thereon from the 1st day of August in the year 1827 which
arose from the sale of the land of Thomas J. Stokes dec'd and which they inherited
from their deceased mother as her property thereof and whereas he is also indebted
to the said Indiana M. I. Evans in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars
with interest from the 25th day of October 1827 it being the price of her negro girl
named Lucy then sold by him and the money received and whereas he is also in-
debted to the said James Rockelle in the sum of forty two dollars and ninety eight
cents due by bond dated the 8th day of December 1827 and payable on demand
and the said James Rockelle is bound as his surety in a Bond due and payable
to Rich R. Shong and Company for one hundred and six dollars and ^{one} pence dated
on the 21st day of June 1830 with a court endorsed for forty dollars paid the
