I do<sup>d</sup> to say<sup>d</sup> I have made this 21<sup>st</sup> day of March in the year of our Lord one  
thousand Eight hundred and thirty one before all Salvmt of the one part and Benjamin B.  
Bampf of the other part the form of the County of Southampton and State of North Carolina  
and the latter of the County of Hertford and State aforesaid witnesseth that whereas the  
said Matt Bryant by virtue of a Deed in Trust executed to him by Bennett Stephenson  
Bampf the 15<sup>th</sup> to secure the payment of a certain debt due to Messrs Joseph G. Ria and Benjamin  
Bampf merchants and partners trading under the firm of Ria and Bampf Esqrs  
unto said Salvmt a certain tract or parcel of Land tenements and hereditaments lying  
in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Containing by estimation one hundred  
and forty four acres which deed is dated the 11<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1839 and duly re-  
corded to record in said County of Southampton in the Clerk's Office the 11<sup>th</sup> of March  
of the same year reference being had to said Deed will make the same fully appear  
the said Salvmt after giving the necessary notice required by law did in trust  
deed on the day and date of these presents respecc to public sale in the Town of  
Jerusalem before the Tavern house door of Peter Bryant the said tract or parcels  
of Land tenements and hereditaments and the said Benjamin Bampf became the last  
and highest bidder for the sum of Eighty dollars et on this Indenture witnesseth  
that for and in Consideration of the said sum of Eighty dollars to the said Salvmt  
in hand paid by the said Bampf before the ensing and delivery of these pro-  
mises do buy and Convey unto the said Benjamin Bampf the tract or  
parcel of Land tenements and hereditaments lying and being in the County of  
Southampton aforesaid Containing by estimation One hundred and forty four acres  
be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit by the lands of Jacob  
Stephenson Arthur Holloman David Boykin and others it being the same  
mentioned in the Deed in Trust aforesaid To have and to hold unto the  
said Benjamin Bampf his heirs and assigns forever and the said Salvmt  
do hereby remand the title of said Land to C. so far and no further arrested  
in him as trustee aforesaid On W<sup>m</sup>ch<sup>th</sup> whereof the said Salvmt hath huncert  
his hand and affixed his seal the day and year first mentioned
