 Calvert This Indenture made this 29<sup>th</sup> day of March in the year of our Lord one  
 To thousands eight hundred and thirty one between said Calvert of the one part and Benjamin B  
 Camp of the other part the form of the County of Northampton and State of North Carolina  
 and the latter of the County of Northford and State aforesaid Witnesseth that whereas the  
 I did to wit said all said Calvert by virtue of a deed in Trust executed to him by Benjamin B  
 Camp the 15<sup>th</sup> to secure the payment of a certain debt due to Messrs Joseph P. Pka and Benjamin  
 day of Aug 1831 B Camp merchants and partners trading under the firm of Pka and Camp conveying  
 unto said Calvert a certain tract or parcel of Land tenements and hereditaments lying  
 in the County of Northampton and State of Virginia containing by estimation one hundred  
 and forty four acres 10 acres and is dated the 11<sup>th</sup> day of March 1829 and duly ad-  
 mitted to record in said County of Northampton in the Clerk's Office the 16<sup>th</sup> of March  
 of the same year reference being had to said Deed will make the same fully appear  
 the said Calvert after giving the necessary notice required by said deed and in Trust  
 did on the day and date of these presents expose to public sale in the form of  
 Jerusalem before the Tavern house door of James Bryant the said tract or parcel  
 of Land tenements and hereditaments and the said Benjamin B Camp became the best  
 and highest bidder for the sum of Eighty dollars at on this Indenture Witnesseth  
 that for and in consideration of the said sum of Eighty dollars to the said Calvert  
 in hand paid by the said Camp before the executing and delivery of these pres-  
 ents do bargain sell and convey unto the said Benjamin B Camp the tract or  
 parcel of Land tenements and hereditaments lying and being in the County of  
 Northampton aforesaid containing by estimation one hundred and forty four acres  
 be the same more or less and bounded as follows bounded by the lands of Joseph  
 Stephenson to three Hollenars David Boykin and others it being the same  
 mentioned in the Deed in Trust aforesaid To Have and to hold unto the  
 said Benjamin B Camp his heirs and assigns forever and the said Calvert  
 do hereby warrant the title of said Land &c so far and no further as vested  
 in him as trustee aforesaid In Witness whereof the said Calvert hath hereunto set  
 his hand and affixed his seal the day and year first mentioned  
 Signed sealed &c

 This Indenture was acknowledged by Matthew Calvert being there and  
 admitted to record And at a Court held for the County aforesaid the 20<sup>th</sup> day
