This Indenture made and entered this 16th day of May 1831 between
Charles L. Wingfield Marshal of the Superior Court of Chancery for the
County of the one part and Joseph Edmunds of Southampton of the other
part Witnesses that whereas by a decree of the Superior Court of Chancery for
the Williamsburg District in Cause thereina depending between James
Nochelle in his own right and as Executor of Henry M. Gray dec^d Plaintiff
against William Puelles and Mary his wife. William B. Gooden and
Thomas Kelly ad^{rs} with the wife annexed of Thomas Kelly dec^d and
Piles Summerville Committee of the estates of William Hart and Lewis Hight
and Samuel Hardy Deft^s. Before the said Charles L. Wingfield as clerk of the
aforesaid it is decided to make sale of the house and lot with its appurtenances sit-
uate in the town of Jerusalem in the County aforesaid the same being the lot
of which William Hart dec^d seized and possessed at which sale the said
Joseph Edmunds became the purchaser at the price of twelve hundred
and sixty dollars. Now therefore this Indenture Witnesseth that the
said Charles L. Wingfield Marshal aforesaid in consideration of the sum
of twelve hundred and sixty dollars to him in hand paid at or before the making
and delivery of these presents hath granted bargained sold aliened conveyed
and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and alien convey
and confirm to the said Joseph Edmunds his heirs and assigns forever
the said house and lot with its appurtenances situate in the town of Jerusalem
in the County aforesaid as ^{above} described To have and to hold the said house and
lot with its appurtenances as aforesaid to him the said Joseph Edmunds
his heirs and assigns forever And the said Charles L. Wingfield Marshal
as aforesaid for himself his heirs and all others claiming by, through, or under him
but not otherwise the house and lot with its appurtenances as before described to
him the said Joseph Edmunds his heirs and assigns forever shall and
lawfully warrant and forever defend In Testimony whereof The said
Charles L. Wingfield as Marshal aforesaid hath hereunto set his hand and
