 Compler the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and
 by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Benjamin Compler his heirs
 and assigns all that tract or parcel of Land lying and being on Block Water River in
 the County of Southampton and now in the possession of John Pinnell which said tract
 of Land they the said Joseph Scott and his wife Francis claim title to through
 Frances the wife of said Scott as one of the heirs at law of Arthur Pinnell deceased
 late of the County of Southampton to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of
 Land with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said Benjamin Compler
 his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoef of said Benjamin
 Compler his heirs and assigns forever And the said Joseph Scott and Francis his
 wife their heirs Executors and administrators do hereby covenant and agree to and with
 the said Benjamin Compler his heirs and assigns that they the said Joseph Scott
 and his wife Francis the said tract or parcel of Land with its appurtenances
 unto the said Benjamin Compler his heirs and assigns against them the said
 Joseph Scott and his wife Francis and their heirs and against all persons what-
 soever shall and will and by these presents do forever warrant and defend
