Robert A. Rogers & Lucy Whitefield Relivers to R. Whitefield July 18/34

This Indenture made and entered into this 18th day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty one Between Robert A. Rogers & Lucy his wife formerly Whitefield of the first part William M. Cutler of the second part and Bennett H. Whitefield of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesses that whereas John Whitefield his last Will and Testament which is duly recorded in the Clerks office of Southampton County did devise and bequeath a certain tract of Land containing three hundred and sixty eight acres more or less to his son Payson Whitefield to him and his heirs forever provided however that if the said Payson Whitefield departed this life without an heir or heirs lawfully begotten then and in that case the said tract of land to descend to his the said John Whitefield's three daughters namely Matilda, Peggy, and Lucy Whitefield to be equally divided between them and their heirs forever and as the said Payson Whitefield not having any, departed this life without having a lawful heir or heirs which alone would entitle them to a fee simple estate therein and the said Robert A. Rogers and Lucy his wife in consequence of the usufructuary right of the said Payson Whitefield having at this time a right of expectancy to at least one third of the aforesaid tract of land containing as aforesaid three hundred and sixty eight acres more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton near the Piney Groves and bounded by the lands of Nancy Magot, William M. Cutler, Lewis Howell and others whose lands in many respects of Howell, Summ & and Tenanted by the aforesaid Bennett H. Whitefield, and the said Robert A. Rogers being justly indebted to the said Bennett H. Whitefield in the sum of seventy three dollars and fifty two cents due by promissory note bearing equal date and on demand by these presents and the said Robert A. Rogers being willing and desirous to do unto the said Bennett H. Whitefield the amount of the aforesaid note of seventy three dollars and fifty two cents with the interest which may thereon lawfully accrue from this Indenture fixture Whitefield that the said Robert A. Rogers and Lucy his wife for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid, as well for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to them in hand paid or before the making and delivery of these presents, had the receipt of which before the making and delivery of hereof they do hereby acknowledge have granted, bargained and sold and do by these presents grant bargain and sell to him the said William M. Cutler his heirs, executors and assigns the full and entire property, joint and several interest right and title which they now have in expectancy or may hereafter have in fee simple in and to the aforesaid part of Land lying in the County of Southampton
