of our Lord 1830 between Isham Whitfield, Jr., of the County of Southampton and state
Magt. Trustee of Virginia of the first part. Nancy May, ^{trustee} of the second part, and Lewis Worrall, Jr.,
Economic & Co^d Hargrave and Thomas B. Worrall of the third part all of the parties of the aforesaid
to Jacob Jordan County of Southampton and state of Virginia witnesseth that whereas the said
for Thomas B. Isham Whitfield stands fully indebted unto the said Lewis Worrall by
Worrall Bonds bearing date January 18th 1830 for the sum of Fifty three dollars to John
Hargrave by Bond bearing date February 10th 1830 for the sum of forty thousand
dollars and twenty cents and to Thomas B. Worrall by Bond bearing date Jan-
uary 18th 1830 for the sum of forty three dollars the above sums being the amount
the said Lewis Worrall John Hargrave and Thomas B. Worrall paid to Col. Middleton
Coroner for said Isham Whitfield (for or an execution in favour
of the estate of John Durham due him and he the said Isham Whitfield being
desirous and willing to secure the aforesaid debts and the interest thereon according
had for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar current money of Virginia
to him in hand paid by the said Nancy Magt. Trustee at or before the enacting
and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath
been bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell
alway enfeoff and confirm unto him the said Nancy Magt. Trustee his heirs
and assigns forever the following personal property to wit two Jack planes three
Goro planes one jointer two Carpenters adge three Squares two Augers 1 in. & 1 1/4
inch six Chisels one Smoothing plane five floor dogs three wide Chisels
three small gongs two Hand Saws and one Back Saw one Broad axe and one
Hatchet two Claw Hammers one Glue pot, lead, one Compass Saw one Broach
thirty Bits traversing ploughs and eight iron three scriwing chisel and one firmer
chisel one Hand scriwing too large Rabit planes two rasing planes two corner planes
two small Rabit planes (square faces) two Planes scriwing planes one circular saw
