IInd. Indenture made this 24th day of June in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and thirty one. Between James Hendough of the County of
 Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Amos Stephenson of the said
 County and State of the other part witnesseth that the said James Hendough
 and in Consideration of the sum of twenty five hundred dollars to him in hand paid
 the said Amos Stephenson at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these
 presents do bargain and sell unto the said Amos Stephenson his heirs and assigns
 One certain tract or parcel of Land situated lying and being in the aforesaid County
 of Southampton Containing by a recent Survey Eight hundred acres to the dimensions
 or less and bounded as follows North Beginning at a white oak standing a corner in the
 Cain's line thence South 47° 11' 42" poles to an oak S. 36° 10' 23" E. S. 33° 11' 12" poles
 Black oak S. 14° 10' 14" E. to a western oak on Thomas Etchisons line S. 44° 54' 11" E.
 to a Hickory S. 33° 11' 42" poles to a dead hickory S. 46° 11' 42" E. to a corner acomd
 of said Etchison and Stanley Worrell at 49° E. 41° 0' E. to a small Elm at 55° 57' 10" poles
 Corner pine S. 44° 11' E. 16" poles to a corner Black Elm at 55° 57' 10" E. to a corner pine 48°
 10' 48" E. 33° 11' 42" poles to a corner post at the field at 58° E. 68° E. to a corner Black Elm
 at said Worrells gate thence to an oak a corner between said land and Samuel Bryant
 thence the dividing line between said Land and said Samuel Bryant at 50° 13' 15" poles
 to an ash in Clarkells Swamp thence up the said swamp to a black gum acomd
 of James W. Parker at 28° 11' 5" 23" poles to an oak at 47° 11' 42" E. to a corner pine 43°
 11' 48" E. to a pine at Brann's road corner of said Parker and Famy. Thence
 up along the said road 36° 9" E. to a pine a corner of Jacob Williams or Mr. Robert
 Vaughan's line S. 53° 6' 27" 1. poles to a hickory S. 10° 56' 39" E. 44° 54' 11" poles to the beginning
 together with all and singular the premises and appurtenances therunto belonging
 in any wise appertaining or as belonging to the same or any part thereof and the
 services and conveniences thereunto and remainders of any and other rents if any
 profits thereof and of every fruit and frument thereof to have and to hold the said
 tract or parcel of Land with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular other
 the premises herein before mentioned intended to be bargained and sold and every
 part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the
 said Amos Stephenson his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only purpose and
 behoef of him the said Amos Stephenson his heirs and assigns forever the said
 the said James Hendough for himself and his heirs the said tract or parcel
 of Land unto which all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned
 unto the said Amos Stephenson his heirs and assigns free from the claim of
