 thousand Eight hundred and thirty one. Between James Hurdough of the County of
 Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Amos Stephenson of the said
 County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said James Hurdough for
 and in Consideration of the sum of Twenty five hundred dollars to him in hand paid by
 the said Amos Stephenson at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these
 presents do bargain and sell unto the said Amos Stephenson his heirs and assigns
 One Certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County
 of Southampton containing by a recent Survey Eight hundred acres be the same
 or left and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a white oak depicting a corner in
 John's line thence South 11¹/₂° N 42 poles to an oak S 36.10 22p E 33.11 12p to
 Black oak S 14.10 14p to a yellow oak in Thomas's line S 44.6 11p
 to a Hickory S 33.8 14p S 19.6 9 11p to a dead hickory S 44.6 11p to a pine among
 of said Thomas and at any corner at S 19.6 10 p to a street corner at S 55.8 10 p to
 corner point S 44.6 11p E 16 poles to a corner Black Gum at S 55.8 10 p to a corner point S 22
 10 48p N 33.11 12p to a corner point at the pole at S 88.6 68p to a corner Black Gum

 part and parcel thereof with every of their right members and appurtenances unto the
