First Indenture made and entered into this day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty one between William H. Geo of the County of Southampton State of Virginia and John T. Mason of the same part and Thomas D. Kelly and Henry R. Kelly formerly Clerk of the said part Whereas the said William H. Geo is party and to the said Kelly and wife by his Bond executed to the said Henry R. Kelly bearing date on the 5th day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty one the sum of twelve hundred and fifty dollars due and payable on the said 5th day of April 1830 with interest from that date - and whereas the said Geo is willing and desirous effectually to secure the payment of the said sum of money and as aforesaid At or that Indenture With covenants that for and in Consideration of the premises and up the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said John T. Mason party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said William H. Geo hath bargained sold conveyed and conveyed presents doth bargain sell and convey unto the said John T. Mason his heirs and assigns the following property that is to say negro slaves, Miller, Tyals, Hart, and Chad To have and to hold to him the said Masons only proper use and behoof forever. On Trust nevertheless that the said Geo is to retain possession of the aforesaid property until the 31st day of October next at which time if the sum of money aforesaid and the interest thereon shall still be unsatisfied and due to the said Kelly and wife the said Mason Trustees as aforesaid shall take possession thereof and after advertising the time and place of sale for ten days at the Court House of Southampton County shall sell at public auction for cash the property above conveyed or so much thereof as shall be necessary for the purposes aforesaid and if the proceeds pay first the expenses of this trust then the debt and interest aforesaid and the balance if any pay to the said William H. Geo or to his Order. And the said Geo covenants that he will deliver to the said Mason the property aforesaid according to the provisions of this Deed. Kelly County and State of Virginia sold all my interest in the estate of John and John Hines dec'd both real and personal and that he shall have full power and authority to ask challenge and of the said John Hines all property money of whatever that comes belong to me in right of my wife Mildred Hill by virtue of said John Hines's Will or the devise of said Ann Hines and that the receipt
