This Indenture made and entered into on this 18th day of July in the year of
1831. Between Mills Johnson and Anna his wife formerly Anna Rich of the
County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and William Story of the
same County and State of the other part. Witness that the said Mills Johnson
Anna his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and twenty
Dollars Current money of the Common wealth to them in hand paid by the said
Story at & before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
has been acknowledged have granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed
and by these presents they the said Mills Johnson and Anna his wife do and each
of them doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and Confirm unto the said
Story his heirs and assigns forever all their right title and interest which they own
in the tract or parcel of Land and premises lying in the aforesaid County of Henric
and Parish of Saint Andrew of colored Tilghm Creek the full of said Anna Johnson
seized and possessed viz One third part in value of the said tract or parcel of land
which contains by estimation One Hundred and fifty three acres (or the same more
it being the land and plantation whereon the said Tilghm Creek did wherunto
said William Story now resides and homesteaded as follows to wit Beginning in the
Arthur Bramph at a corner Joseph Jordan in Lewis Worrell's line thence
said Joseph Jordan's line to a post oak a corner for said Joseph Jordan Polly Whitfield
doe and others thence along said Polly Whitfield's line to Alfred Story's line thence
his line to the ^{run of the} said Arthur Bramph thence up the stream course of the run of
said Bramph to the beginning To have and to hold One third part in value
of the above described tract or parcel of land and premises with all the right title
interest claim or demand of them the Mills Johnson and Anna his wife
as of or estate of us and to the same unto him the said William Story his heirs
assigns forever (to and for the only purpose and behoof of him the said William Story
his heirs and assigns and the said Mills Johnson and Anna his wife for them
their heirs Executors and administrators do and each of them doth hereby consent
agree to and with the said William Story his heirs Executors and assigns that
they will by these presents and forever defend the right and title of them and
in the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises hereby conveyed or intended to be
conveyed against the claims or demand of all and every person or persons who
soever. In witness whereof the said Mills Johnson and Anna his wife
his wife have hereunto set their hands and Affixed their seals the day and
