This Indenture made and entered into on this 18th day of July in the year of our Lord 1834. Between Mills Johnson and Anna his wife (formerly Anna Rich) of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and William Hogg of the same County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Mills Johnson and Anna his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and twenty Dollars Current money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said William Hogg at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents they the said Mills Johnson and Anna his wife do and each of them doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and Confirm unto the said William Hogg his heirs and assigns forever all their right title and interest which they now have in the tract or parcel of Land and premises lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Lukes of colored Pilgrimage Creek the fuller of said Anna Johnson seized and possessed by One third part in value of the said tract or parcel of land which contains by estimation One hundred and fifty three acres (be the same more or less) being the land and plantation whereon the said Pilgrimage Creek did when the said William Hogg now resides and bounded as follows to wit Beginning in the Arthur Brampton a corner for Joseph Jordan in Lewis Worrell's line thence along said Joseph Jordan's line to a post oak a corner for said Joseph Jordan Polly Whitfield dec^d and others thence along said Polly Whitfield's line to Alfred Story's line thence ^{new of the} his line to it as for said Arthur Brampton thence up the stream course of the same said Brampton to the Beginning To have and to hold One third part in value of the above described tract or parcel of land and premises with all the right title interest claim or demand of them the Mills Johnson and Anna his wife as aforesaid of us and to the same unto him the said William Hogg his heirs and assigns forever (to and for the only purpose and behoof of him the said William Hogg his heirs and assigns and the said Mills Johnson and Anna his wife for their three hundred and administrators do and each of them doth hereby consent agree to and with the said William Hogg his heirs Executors administrators and assigns that they will by these presents and forever defend the right and title of them and theirs in the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises hereby conveyed or intended to be hereby conveyed against the claims or demand of all and every person or persons who soever.
