and thirty one between William D. Morris of the first part Charles A. Briggs of the second
part and Richard P. Nicholls of the third part: Whereas the said William Morris
is justly indebted to the said Richard P. Nicholls in the sum of five hundred dollars
paid as follows One bond due the 25th December 1833 for One hundred dollars and another
do the 25th December 1833, also another bond due the 25th December 1833 for two hundred dollars
each which debt the said William Morris is willing and desirous to discharge: And
Wherefore the said William Morris has granted sold aliened conveyed released and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant
Constitution of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the said William Morris for the said
