by estimation two hundred and forty acres to the same more or less bounded as follows
on the North by Henry Gillett and Penitie Battle on the South by Thomas Barr
on the East by Gers^t Branch and Martha Rothe and on the West by Herbert

ments and hereditaments whatsoever thereunto appertaining and the said John T
