Smith acknowledged the same to be his act and deed and desired us to certify the same to the Clerk of Southampton in order that the same may be recorded. Governor or Chief Magistrate of the Commonwealth of Virginia and his Successors in the just and full sum of Five thousand dollars for which payment well and truly to be made to the said Governor and his Successors we bind ourselves our heirs Executors and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 18th day of July 1831.

The Condition of the above obligation is such that the above bound Samuel M. Bond has been duly appointed a Constable in the upper district of Nottingham Parish in the County of Southampton for the term of two years next ensuing. And therefore if the said Samuel M. Bond shall well and truly do, execute, and perform the duties of his official Constable during his continuance therein then the above obligation to be and also to remain in full force and virtue.
