I know all men by these presents that I Littlepage Anderson of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia for and in Consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars (\$150) in hand paid by the said John Banitt of the said County and State have on this 18th day of July 1831 bargained and sold and do hereby grant bargain and sell unto him the said John Banitt all my right title interest and estate in and to a certain parcel of negro slaves, which I am or may be entitled to that parcel belong to or was in the possession of Rachel Anderson dec^d during her life named as follows Gلاب, Mimy, Sam, John, William and Stephen to him the said John Banitt and his heirs forever free from the claim of him the said Littlepage Anderson or his heirs & free from the claim or claims of all and every person or persons who shall own, do by these presents warrant and forever hereafter defend the right and title of the said negro slaves unto him the said John Banitt and his heirs forever.
