This Indenture made this 14th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty One between Matthew & Thomas and his wife Elizabeth, of the first part and Iesep Burton of the other part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said Iesep Burton at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Matthew & Thomas and wife Elizabeth have this day granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant buy and sell unto the said Iesep Burton two tracts or parcels of land lying and being in the County of Southampton on the north side of Jones' and Parsons' Mill Pond and bounded by the lands of Benjamin E. Blunt, William A. Jones and the aforesaid Mill pond one of which tracts contains by estimation One hundred and thirty acres divided from the other tract by the road leading through it which was allotted to David Thomas in the division between his mother Dorothy Thomas and himself by will of his father David Thomas well the proportion of which tract will be given to the said Iesep Burton on the 25th day of December next ensuing. The other tract is a parcel of land leased in the will of Thomas die^d to his wife Dorothy and at her death given to the aforesaid David Thomas containing by estimation acres and lying on the south side of the aforesaid road, proprietor of the said tract to be given to the said Iesep Burton at the death of the said Dorothy Thomas and Dorothy Smith together with all and way of the improvements on both tracts of land thereto belonging or appertaining unto him the said Iesep Burton his heirs executors and assigns forever him the said Matthew & Thomas and wife Elizabeth for themselves their and each of their heirs executors and assigns against the claimed demand of themselves or any other person or persons claiming under them and against the claim and demand of all and every other person or persons whatsoever with the exception of any future dom rights which the present wife of David Henry Thomas may be entitled to claim as done by the death of her husband doth acknowledge forever defend the right and title of the said two tracts or parcels of land together with all improvements thereto attached unto him the said Iesep Burton his heirs executors and assigns of all the rights and titles of the said two tracts or parcels of land he holds the day and date first above written.
