& Thomas parties thereto admitted to record And at a Court held for the County
aforesaid the 15th day of August 1831 The said Indenture receipt and cer-

(Witness) This Indenture made this 16th day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and thirty one Between William Ellis and Patsy his wife of the one
part and Littleton Moore of the other part all of the County of Southampton in the
State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said William Ellis and Patsy his wife
for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and two dollars to them in hand paid
by the said Littleton Moore at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said William Ellis and Patsy
his wife have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them do bar-
gain and sell unto the said Littleton Moore his heirs and assigns a certain tract
or parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton marked
and bounded as follows Beginning at a pine at the edge of the fox trap branch a
corner on the line of Peter Moore due thence S 79° W 12 p. to a red oak then S 43°
W 10 p. to a pine then S 44° W 11 p. to a red oak then S 66° W 37 p. to a pine corner
on the line of the said Peter Moore thence S 50° 08 p. to a cypress a corner on the
Ravels thence along said Ellis' line S 70° E 18 p. to a pine then S 67° E 76 p. to the said
Moore's line then along Moore's line S 5° W 63 p. to the beginning Containing thirty
four acres more or less together with all and singular the revenues and revenues
remainder and remainders appurtenant and other rents issues and profits thereof and every
part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with the
tenements thereto appurtenant and all and singular other the premises therein before men-
tioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof unto the said
Littleton Moore his heirs and assigns forever and the said William Ellis and Patsy
his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract or parcel of Land with all and sin-
gular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Littleton Moore
his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said William Ellis
and Patsy his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every
