Barker To This Indenture made this 8th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
Blond hundred and thirty one William Littleton Barker of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part, Solomon Davis Trustee of the same part and Benjamin E. Blunt of the third part (Witnesseth) that whereas the said Littleton Barker is justly indebted to the said Benjamin E. Blunt in one written obligation from under the hand and seal of the said Littleton Barker for fifty nine dollars and sixty seven cents on demand the 1st day of July 1831 also one Bond executed to Joseph A. Horton for twenty two dollars and fifty cents due the 30th day of December 1831 in which the said Benjamin E. Blunt is bound as security for him the said Littleton Barker also one Bond executed to James Harris for three dollars and thirty five cents due July 8th 1831 which the said Littleton Barker is willing and desirous to secure from this Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Howell Harris at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Littleton Barker hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell unto the said Howell Harris his heirs and assigns forever the following property to wit one plaster bed and furniture one sorrel horse one man's saddle all my ~~interest~~ ^{the same} in the entire crops all of kind now growing on the premises of him the said Benjamin E. Blunt as his or share consisting of Corn Cotton fodder oats, Peas, &c. also my interest in the crop now growing on the land of Statham at Thomas 12 acres by one the said Littleton Barker and Mary Harris consisting of Corn Cotton fodder, Peas, &c. To have and to hold the said property herein before mentioned unto the said Howell Harris his heirs and assigns forever and the said Littleton Barker do for myself my heirs &c. assign and confirm unto the said Howell Harris his heirs Executor administrator and assigns the property herein before mentioned and the said Littleton Barker doth warrant and firmly defend the said property against all and every other person or persons whatsover notwithstanding and upon this express condition that if the said Littleton Barker shall fail to make punctual payment of the debt aforesaid on or before the 1st day of December next and the interest and costs which may accrue thereon then in that case the said Howell Harris as Trustee at the request of the said Benjamin E. Blunt and James Harris shall after giving ten days notice proceed to sell to the highest bidder for cash Virginia money all the property herein before mentioned and out of the monies arising from such sale shall after satisfying the charges thereof and all other expenses attending such sale pay to the said Benjamin E. Blunt and James Harris their heirs Executor administrator
