Barker To Blunt This Indenture made this 8th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty one between Littleton Parker of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part Amos Harris Trustee of the sum part and Benjamin E. Blunt of the third part (Witnesseth) that whereas the said Littleton Parker is greatly indebted to the said Benjamin E. Blunt in one written obligation from under his hand and seal of the said Littleton Parker for fifty nine dollars and sixty seven cents on demand the 1st day of July 1831 also one bond executed to J. D. Maupin for thirty two dollars and fifty cents due the 30th day of December 1831 in which the said Benjamin E. Blunt is bound as security for him the said Littleton Parker also one bond executed to James Harris for three dollars and thirty five cents due July 8th 1831 which the said Littleton Parker is willing and desirous to secure to me This Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia given in hand paid by the said Amos Harris at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Littleton Parker hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell unto the said Amos Harris his heirs and assigns forever the following property to wit one feather bed and furniture one stool horse one man's saddle all my ~~belongings~~ in the entire Crops all of kind now growing on the premises of him the said Benj. E. Blunt as his overseer consisting of one cotton field oats barley &c also my interest in the Crop now growing on the land of Nathan & Thomas owned by one the said Littleton Parker and Mary Harris consisting of one cotton field barley &c To have and to hold the said property herein before mentioned unto the said Amos Harris his heirs and assigns forever and the said Littleton Parker do for myself my heirs &c executors and administrators unto the said Amos Harris his heirs Executors administrators and assigns the property hereinbefore mentioned and the said Littleton Parker with warrant and fierme idem the said property against all and every other person or persons whatsoever I doth set up and upon this express condition that if the said Littleton Parker shall fail to make a punctual payment of the debt aforesaid on or before the 25th day of December next and the interest and costs which may accrue thereon then in that case the said Amos Harris as Trustee at the request of the said Benjamin E. Blunt and James Harris shall after giving ten days notice proceed to sell to the highest bidder for Cash Bremen money all the property hereinbefore mentioned and out of the monies arising from such sale shall after satisfying the charges thereof and all other expenses attending such sale pay to the said Benjamin E. Blunt and James Harris their heirs Executors Administrators
