This Indenture made this 25th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty one between Matthew Bulls the debtor of the first part Benjamin Griffin Trustee of the second part and Henry Linon Creditor of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Whereas the said Matthew Bulls is justly indebted unto the said Henry Linon in the sum of One Hundred and Twenty five dollars by bond bearing date 25th day of February 1831 as well as all other moneys which may be due and owing from the said Matthew Bulls to the said Henry Linon with interest thereon till paid which the said Matthew Bulls is well and lawfully desirous to secure and for this Indenture Witten first that and in consideration of the premises and also for the further sum of One dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the said Bulls in hand paid by the said Benjamin Griffin at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Matthew Bulls hath given granted bargained and sold released and confirmed and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell unto the said Benjamin Griffin his heirs and assigns forever the following Land to wit One tract containing by estimation Seventy nine and three fourths acres and bounded by the land of Henry Harris deceased (Frederick Lawrence Junior and Jeremiah Junior references thereto being this serial more fully appear containing by estimation twenty and three fourths acres and bounded with all the interest right title claim or demand of the above mentioned property To have and to hold the said hereby granted or intended to be hereby granted property or land hereby conveyed unto the said Benjamin Griffin his heirs and assigns and assigns forever and the said Matthew Bulls for himself his heirs and assigns do hereby covenant promise and agree to and with the said Benjamin Griffin his heirs &c in manner and form following that is to say that the
