 This Indenture made and entered into this 18th day of June one thousand Eight hundred and thirty one by and between William Stratton Sampson, of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, Wmth Smith that the said William Stratton for and in consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by Giles Russ (which said dollar and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell unto the said Giles Russ one hundred acres of Land on the East and Southeast of the lands of Sampson Co. Russ and in the said County of Southampton and the said Stratton doth for himself, heirs and assigns the title of or to the said tract of Land of one hundred acres being part of the land wherein he resides to the said Giles Russ his heirs and assigns on trust nevertheless and it is the true intent and meaning of these presents that should the said Stratton make default in the payment of a bond issued by the said Stratton this day to the said Sampson Russ for the sum of ten pounds and five dollars and Eighty one cents on or before the 18th day of October next that then the said Giles or being required by the said Sampson Russ having given twenty days notice in some public place in the said County and shall sell the said hundred acres of Land aforesaid to the highest bidder for cash and pay the said Bond and the costs and charges attending the sale but should the said Stratton pay this bond and interest aforesaid then the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue In Testimony whereof the parties have hereunto set their hands and seals this day and date first before written

Lawrence their son of the second part all being of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia: Wmth Smith that witness for and in consideration of the love and affection that doth exist from William Lawrence and his wife Catherine toward their son William E. Lawrence they have given granted alienated and confirmed unto the said William E. Lawrence his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract and parcel of land lying and being in the lower part of a certain tract and parcel of land lying and being the said William Lawrence now resides lying between the house and the tract of land formerly belongs to William Mills dec^d containing by survey Eighty acres and is bounded as follows viz Beginning at a black gum a corner between Mills farm and the John Mills tract which the said William E. Lawrence purchased at public auction September 8th 1830 and the tract given away to the
