Edward his heirs &c against all persons whome shall ans and will clellant and forever defend by these presents upon trust moreover left that the said Littleton R. Edward his heirs executors and administrators shall permit to said Matthias Williams to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of the said two tracts or parcels of land and promises with all their appurtenances and take the profits thereof to his own use with the exception of removing any of the improvements thereto belonging until default be made in the payment of the sum of five hundred and fifty five dollars and ninety eight cents otherwise whole or in part and then upon this further trust that they or any two or other of them or the survivor of them or their heirs executors or assigns or Carr Darden his heirs executors &c shall request sell the said two tracts of land and promises with the appurtenances or such part of the hereby granted premises as the Trustee his representative hereby authorizes to act shall think sufficient for the purpose and chink proper to sell to the highest bidder for ready money at public auction having fixed the time and place of sale at his discretion and given to day notice thereof at the door of the Court house for the said County on some certain day and at one or more public places near where the land lies pursuant to the day of sale and out of the monies arising from such sale shall after deducting the charges thereof and all other expenses attending the premises pay to the said Carr Darden his heirs executors or assigns the said sum of five hundred and fifty five dollars and ninety eight cents with the interest which may thereon lawfully have accrued and the balance if any shall pay to the said Matthias Williams his heirs executors or assigns But if the whole of the amount aforesaid shall be paid off and discharged to the said Carr Darden his heirs executors or assigns on or before the 20th day of March 1832 when the last of said sums is due so that no default of payment be made then this indenture to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue notwithstanding whereof the said parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and date first written
