 to the said James Davis Senior and also the sum of forty dollars or thereabouts due from Thomas
 Gray of the County of Southampton aforesaid; to the said James Davis Junior as such Executor
 as aforesaid and also the further sum of One hundred dollars or thereabouts due from George
 Branch of said County of Southampton to the said James Davis Senior as such Executor as
 aforesaid And also as such agent and Attorney in fact as aforesaid to demand to receive ask
 for and receive from any person or persons whatever who may in any way be indebted to the
 said James Davis Junior as such Executor as aforesaid either in the County of Southampton
 aforesaid or else where in the State of Virginia any and all sums or sums of money which in
 any manner whatever may be due or owing to the said James Davis Junior as such Executor as
 aforesaid And be it further known that the said James Davis Junior as such Executor as
 aforesaid and the said James Davis Junr have fully empowered ordained constituted and
 appointed the said Lang Gay their agent and Attorney in fact for us and in our several
 names or names as aforesaid to ask for demand and receive the several sums of money herein
 stated as aforesaid from the several persons herein mentioned and also for the collection thereof to
 sue and institute all such suits for the recovery and collection of the same and in our
 several names or names legally to receipt for any and all sums of money which our said Attorney
 as aforesaid for us in the premises herein may receive as amply and as fully to all intents
 and purposes whatever as though we were personally present to act in the premises
