hundred and thirty one by and between Mills Wick and Dorothy his wife of the County of Kentuck-
town in the State of Virginia and in the lower district of Saint Luke's Parish of the one part and John
Hargrave of the said County and Parish of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Mills
Wick and Dorothy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of fifty three dollars and forty
cents to them in hand paid by the said John Hargrave at or before the making and delivery of
these presents the receipt whereof they the said Mills Wick and Dorothy his wife do not
hereby acknowledge themselves fully satisfied in full content and paid bargain sold alien in full
and confirm and by these presents doth hereby bargain and sell alien in full and confirm
unto the said John Hargrave his heirs and assigns a certain messuage Plantation tract or parcel of
land, situated lying and being in the County aforesaid containing therein and together acres
bounded as follows to wit. Beginning at a corner of Patience Wick in John Hargrave's line
thence along his line at 22 1/4 Edg poles to a post oak thence at 24 Edg poles to a sapling
thence at 22 Edg poles to a black gum and white oak standing on the creek neck branch
corner for a survey To be thence along her line up said branch at 80 Edg poles to a small pine
a corner for said survey To be and said John Hargrave thence along said Hargrave's line
at 77 1/4 Edg poles to a post corner made for said Mills Wick in said Hargrave's line
thence along a new line of marked trees at 20 1/4 Edg poles to a small pine a new corner made
