This Indenture made this 15th day of August 1831 between Benjamin B. Camp of the
County of Beaufort and State of North Carolina of the one part and Solomon Fitchet of the County of
Suffolk and State of Virginia of the other part. Witnesseth that for and in Consideration
of the sum of Eighty dollars to me in hand paid at or before the making and delivering of this
indenture and payment by the said Benjamin B. Camp hereby acknowledged to have granted to the
said Fitchet all land enclosed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and
Aug. 15. 1831. Assign unto him the said Solomon Fitchet his heirs and assigns a certain tract
or parcel of land, lying and being in the County of Southampton and containing by estimation
Eighty and forty four acres, to the same more or less and bounded as follows: East by the land
of Joseph Stephenson Arthur Holloman David Boggs and others it being the same tract
of Land which was formerly in trust by Barnard Stephenson et al. for the children
of Revd. Mr. Camp as will more fully appear by reference to said Deed of Trust record
in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County, Virginia and to hold unto the said Solomon Fitchet
his heirs and assigns forever with all and singular the appurtenances profits and emoluments
to the same belonging And I the said Benjamin B. Camp doth for myself my heirs executors
administrators command and agree to and with the said Solomon Fitchet his heirs and assigns
that he will by these presents warrant and defend a good and perfect right and title in fee
simple to the said Solomon Fitchet his heirs of &c in the aforesaid tract of land hereby conveyed
against the claim or demand of any person or persons whatsoever. In witness whereof I the said
Benjamin B. Camp have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the day and date before written

This Indenture made this 25th day of April 1831 between Polly Gray of the County of Land
ampton and Parish of St. Thomas of the one part and Matthew Williams of the same County and State
of the other part. Witnesseth that I the said Polly Gray for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty
five dollars good money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Matthew Williams the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Polly Gray full and simply satisfied and paid
hath granted bargained sold and confirmed and by these presents hath granted bargained and sold
unto the said Matthew Williams one certain tract or parcel of land, and premises situate lying
and being in the County aforesaid containing by estimation by a late survey, twenty six acres to the
same more or less and bounded as follows: Beginning at a gunn in a bottom on a corner of
Matthew Williams' line, Joseph Vick's line and John Vick's line 111 1/2 poles to a maple a tree corner in the said Vick's line channel, E. 10 3/4 poles to a pine in a bottom a corner of the said Matthew Williams and Edward Vick's
line then up the various corners of said Survey to the beginning together with all houses
out houses offices buildings yards gardens orchards ways water waterways & all that now
belonging or in any way appertaining to have and to hold the said land to him the said Matthew
Williams to him and his heirs forever and the said Polly Gray for herself her heirs and assigns
and from henceforth by these presents or any person or persons claiming or demanding the same money
