 To Turner his wife both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and
 Lewis Williams Harris of the same County and State of the other parts, *Wm* & parts that the
 said John Turner and Mary Ann his wife for and in consideration of the sum of five
 few dollars lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Williams Harris
 the receipt whereof the said John Turner and Mary Ann his wife doth acknowledge
 themselves fully satisfied and paid hath granted bargained and sold and confirmed unto
 their presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Williams Harris to him and his
 heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of Land wherein the said John Turner now lives
 being in the County aforesaid and in the Parish of St. Mary containing twenty five acres
 be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit: Beginning at a post set at the lower
 end of Nathan Turner's land thence along a line of marked trees in Williams Harris's
 thence along a line of marked trees in Elizabeth Hill's downland, thence along a line
 of marked trees between John Turner and his sister Patsy Turner's land, thence
 along a line of marked trees between John Turner and Jesse Penkford to a maple
 a corner tree standing in the branch thence along a line of marked trees between John Turner
 and Nathan Turner's to the first beginning together with all houses orchards other
 sower belonging to this tract or parcel of land, To Have and to hold the said land with
 all its profits unto him the said Williams Harris and to his heirs forever and the said John
 Turner and Mary Ann his wife for themselves their heirs Executors administrators and
 assigns doth by these presents covenant and grant to and with the said Williams Harris
