 paid the receipt whereof the said Parker and wife do hereby acknowledge received by us
 Alexander and Conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain sell and Convey unto
 the said Alexander P. Price his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land
 lying in the County aforesaid containing seven hundred and thirty nine acre or thereabouts
 more or less and bounded as follow to wit Beginning at the intersection of Cafford road
 and James's Branch thence across the said branch the various courses to below
 mill (now Riddell's) pond, and the intersections of that and the Schoolhouse branch
 thence around that branch the various courses thereof to a lightning stump a corner of Thomas
 Mardens (now Amos Stephenson's) thence along a line of marked trees at 3000 ft
 thence at 25 deg. E. 3000 ft. thence at 47 deg. N. 5000 ft. 4068 pole to the road
 thence the same course at 46 deg. N. 14 poles to a pine a corner of Thomas Mardens (now
 Amos Stephenson) on the side of Banors road thence along the said road at 49 deg. 8236
 thence along the said Cafford road at 33 deg. 210 poles to the beginning. It having and to have
 the said tract or parcel of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said
 Alexander P. Price his heirs and assigns to the only purpose and intent of him the said Alexander
 and Conveyed and assigns forever. And the said James W. Parker and Martha
 Ann his wife for themselves their heirs and assigns do hereby covenant agree to and
 with the said Alexander P. Price his heirs and assigns that the said James W.
 Parker and Martha Ann his wife and their heirs the said tract or parcel of Land until
 its appurtenances unto him the said Alexander P. Price his heirs and assigns against
 them the said James W. Parker and Martha Ann his wife their heirs and assigns
 and against all persons whomsoever shall and will by these presents garnish and
 defend in testimony whereof the said James W. Parker and Martha Ann his
 wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this 3rd day of September
 One thousand Eight hundred and thirty one.
