I NOW all men by these presents that I James W. Parker of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia for and in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand dollars to me in hand paid by Alexander P. Tusto of the County and State aforesaid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have bargained sold granted and confirmed and by these presents do bargain sell grant and confirm to the said Alexander P. Tusto the following slaves, to wit, Nat, Charles, Sam, Jerry, Dany, Archer, Pasa, Henry, James, Bramble, Patsy, Meggy, Franky, Maria, Hannah, and Lucy, to have and to hold the said slaves and their future increase to the only proper use and behoof of the said Alex and W. P. Tusto his Exors, Adors, and assigns forever. And I the said James W. Parker for myself my Executors and administrators the said slaves with their future increase to the said Alexander P. Tusto his Exors, Adors, and assigns against me the said James W. Parker my Exors, Adors, and assigns and against all and every other person and persons whatsoever who shall well or lawfully or for us defend by these presents.
