the state of Virginia Containing Nine hundred and forty two acres to the same more or
less and bounded as follows to wit by the three Points the land of Thomas Applegate
and others it being the tract of land wherein the said Alexander P. Fiske and Mary
E his wife now live with all and singular the appurtenances to the said tract
parcel of land belonging or in any wise appertaining are all the estate right title and
interest of the said Alexander P. Fiske and Mary E his wife in and to the said
