Witnesseth that the said Amos Drury for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and sixty three dollars and 60 cents unto him in hand paid by the said Henry Leno the receipt of which the said Amos Drury doth hereby acknowledge and himself fully satisfied and paid one of the same doth by these presents acquit the said Henry Leno they the said Amos Drury hath granted bargained sold aliened infessed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain and sell alien infess and confirm unto the said Henry Leno one certain tract plantation or parcel of land containing by estimation one hundred and sixty two acres more or less lying and being situate in the County of Southampton State of Virginia bounded by the lands of Sps^r Crocker Richard Joyner and Jacob Thaddeus and others being the land whereon Saml^l live situate belonging or in any wise appertaining with the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders resents issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said bargain premises with the appurtenances unto the said Henry Leno his heirs and assigns forever and the said Amos Drury for himself his heirs Executors and administrators the said bargain and every part and parcel thereof with all their appurtenances clear exempt and free from all claims or other incumbrances whatsoever unto the said Henry Leno his heirs and assigns against all and every person or persons whatsoever now shall and will be present future tenant and defend.
