Said Indenture made this 1st day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand
 Eight hundred and thirty one. Between Solomon Daughtery and Barbara his wife of the
 County of Edge of the State of Virginia of the one part and Wm. H. Garret of the
 County of Southampton and State aforesaid of the other part. All which parts state
 the said Solomon Daughtery and Barbara his wife for and in consideration of the sum
 of six hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said Wm. H. Garret at or before
 the ensuing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 they the said Solomon Daughtery and Barbara his wife have granted bargain and
 sold and by these presents do and each of them doth grant bargain and sell unto the
 said Wm. H. Garret his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying
 and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton adjoining the lands of Henry
 Forster Edwards (which Wm. H. Garret and others marked as follows to wit
 Beginning at a pine adjoining the line of Hinde McHenry d. 2nd thence 100
 63 poles to a maple which Wm. H. Garret's corner thence S 68. W. to a stake a corner of
 the said Garret's thence at 32. E 86. poles to a gum in the poplar Island branch thence
 up the said branch the several courses of the line 368 poles to a corner of Brown's road
 thence along the said Edwards' line S 64. W 95 poles to his corner red oak thence 27 6
 60 poles to a white oak in Hargis' line thence S 54. E 40 poles to a red oak
 stump thence S 64. E 80 poles to a white oak thence S 70. E 40 poles to a pine a corner of the
 donor land thence along the donor line to a post at the road thence a straight line
 to the Beginning containing two hundred and twenty three and a half acres more
 less the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders of early and other rents
 issues and profits thereof and every part and particle thereof. To have and to hold
 the said tract or parcel of land with the premises and appurtenances before mentioned
 unto the said Wm. H. Garret his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Solomon
 Daughtery and Barbara his wife for themselves their heirs the said tract or parcel of land
 with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said
 Wm. H. Garret his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said
 Solomon Daughtery and Barbara his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs
 and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever well and do warrant and defend
