This Indenture made and entered into this the 23rd day of September in the year one thousand Eight hundred and thirty One Between Thomas Trotter and Jane his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Joshua Preppow of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas Trotter and Jane his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Nine hundred twenty Eight dollars and twenty five Cents lawful money of the United States to them in hand paid by the said Joshua Preppow the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Joshua Preppow his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing two hundred and twenty acres be the same more or less lying and being in the County aforesaid it being the tract of land purchased by the said Thomas Trotter of Samuel May Sr. and is bounded on the east by the lands of David H. Boykin Sr. and on the north west by the lands of John W. Brown on the West by the lands of David H. Boykin Sr. and on the South by the lands of David H. Boykin Sr. and on the South east by the lands of David H. Boykin Sr. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said Joshua Preppow his heirs and assigns to the only proper use & behoof of the said Joshua Preppow his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Thomas Trotter and Jane his wife for themselves their heirs Executors and administrators do hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Joshua Preppow his heirs and assigns that they the said Thomas Trotter and Jane his wife and their heirs the said tract or parcel of land with its appurtenances unto him the said Joshua Preppow his heirs and assigns and against them the said Thomas Trotter and Jane his wife and their heirs and against all persons whomsoever shall and lawfully due presents forever WARRANT and defend.
