Poste, justices of the peace for the County aforesaid in the State of Virginia do hereby certify that Jane Trotter the wife of Thomas Trotter parties to a certain Deed bearing date the 22nd day of September 1831 and heretofore personally appeared before us in our County aforesaid and being examined by us freely and apart from her husband and having the Deed aforesaid fully explained to her she the said Jane acknowledged the same to be her act and deed and declared that she had willingly by said seal of ours delivered the same and wished not to retract it Given under our hands and seals this 23rd day of September 1831.

This Indenture made and entered into this 1st day of October in the year one
thousand Eight hundred and thirty one between Joseph Trotter and Elizabeth his wife
of the County of Southampton of the one part and Thomas Trotter of Southampton
of the other part. Whereas both that the said Joseph Trotter and Elizabeth his wife
in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and fifty two dollars lawful money of the Com-
munity to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Trotter the receipt whereof
herby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents delivered
bargain and sell and convey unto the said Thomas Trotter his heirs and assigns
all my right and interest in a certain tract of land lying and being in the County of
Southampton on the Bobbinkamp swamp which lies betwixn Trotter's land and
property of which land remains undivided betwixn the lines of the said Mary and
Trotter To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the appurte-
nances thereto belonging to him the said Thomas Trotter his heirs and assigns
to the only proper use and benefit of the said Thomas Trotter his heirs and assigns
and the said Joseph Trotter and Elizabeth his wife for themselves their heirs
and administrators do hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Thomas Trotter
and his heirs and assigns that they the said Joseph Trotter and Elizabeth his wife
and their heirs the said tract or parcel of land unto him the said Thomas Trotter his
heirs and assigns and against them the said Joseph Trotter and Elizabeth his wife
and their heirs and against all persons whomever shall and will by these pres-
entures warrant and defend. In witness whereof the said Joseph Trotter and
Elizabeth his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this
