This Indenture made the 3^d day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty one Between Jesse Parker of the one part and Elisha Darden as a Trustee of the Baptist Church at South Quay of the other part both of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said Jesse Parker for and in consideration of the sum of Eleven dollars to him in hand paid by the Treasurer of the Baptist Church at South Quay in Southampton County aforesaid hath granted, bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto the said Elisha Darden as Trustee aforesaid for the use and benefit of the Church aforesaid a certain piece or parcel of land adjoining the Church lands and lying with the west side of the same marked and bounded as followeth Beginning at a pine standing at the road leading from S^c Quay to Jerusalem Church along the road N^o 6 to a post oak then S 22 1/2° W 8 1/2° E to a sweet gum tree, S 7° E 29 1/2° to a pine chest 79° E 1 1/4° to a pine a corner of the meeting house land (then N 7° E 3 1/2° to the beginning) Containing One acre and one tenth more or less the revenues and provisions remained or and remainders of unity and other rents issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said piece or parcel of land as Trustee aforesaid unto the said Elisha Darden for the use and benefit of the Church aforesaid together with all and singular the Tenements hereditaments and premises therein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof And the said Jesse Parker for himself and his heirs the said piece or parcel of land with all and singular the premises of and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Elisha Darden as Trustee aforesaid free from the claim of him the said Jesse Parker his heirs and assigns and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever. Shall and will and do warrant and forever defend by these presents. In Witness whereof the said Jesse Parker hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day & year as first above written

This Indenture made and executed the 24th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty one Between Jesse Parker Harriett Parker and Elisha Darden of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia of the one part, and Willam Wells of the County and State aforesaid of the other part: Whereas by an interlocutory decree made and entered in the County Court of Southampton at August term 1830 in a cause lately depending and undetermined in said Court between Richard and Jackson Gardner infants of Isiah Gardner dec^d during by Peggy Gardner their mother and next friends, and the said Peggy Gardner in her own right Plaintiff, and Isiah Gardner, Robert Gardner and Benjamin Cogdale and Lydia his wife defts, it was decreed and ordered that Jesse Parker Harriett Parker and Elisha Darden after having allotted and set apart to the said Peggy Gardner her right of dower in and for the lands of which Isiah Gardner did die & possessed and after having given ten days notice of the time and place of sale should expose to public auction upon a credit of three months
