Inde Indenture made and entered into on the 2nd day of December in the year of our
Lord 1827. Between Thomas James of a Northampton County and State of Virginia of the one part
the one part and Lewis Worrell of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other
part: Witnesseth that the said Thomas James for and in consideration of the sum of one
thousand seven hundred Dollars current money to him in hand paid by the said Lewis Worrell
at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
has granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain
sell alien convey and confirm unto him the said Lewis Worrell his heirs and assigns forever two
certain tracts or parcels of Situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and
Parish of West Lakes containing by recent survey three hundred and thirty eight and three fourths
acres, to the same more or less, Eighty home plantation One hundred and eighty one and three fourths
acres, and the other tract known by the name of the Holy Land plantation One hundred and eighty
seven acres the said two tracts being the land that formerly belongs to Bennett James dec'd the home
plantation lands as follows To wit Beginning at three gums standing near the Cypress Swamp
a Corner for the land of Benjamin James dec'd thence along said dec'ds line of marked Cross
86. 00 24 poles thence S 82 3/4 W 16 poles thence S 87 1/4 W 3 poles thence S 76. W 53 poles to a
small black gum in Sact. James line thence along his line N 84 poles to the pond. Then thence
up the run of said Pond nearly at right angle to the intersection of the great branch and a small
branch, thence up the run of the said great branch to a corner near the fork thence N 13. N 6
poles to a green pine standing on the North side of the Cypress swamp thence at 18 1/2 N 5 1/2 poles
to a dead pine a corner in Thomas James' line thence along his line at 64. E. 19 poles to the Cen-
tre of the said Cypress road thence along said road at 28. E 20 poles thence at 35. E 24 poles thence
at 43. E 22 poles thence at 22 E 2 poles to a small oak standing near the said road thence at
64 E 12 poles thence at 67 E 29 poles to the run of the aforesaid Cypress swamp thence down the various
courses of the run of said swamp to the first station. The home division of the Holy Land plantation as fol-
low To wit Beginning at a pine a corner for Thomas James in Nancy Newsons line thence along
said Nancy Newsons line of marked Cross S 65 1/2 W 36 poles to the run of a small branch a corner for
said Nancy Newson in Sact. Ramo line thence up the run of said branch along said Sact. Ramo
line at 57 1/2 N 36 poles thence at 62 W 7 poles thence S 75 poles to a sweet gum a corner thence S 87
5 poles to a corner in the old field thence S 55 1/2 W 124 poles thence S 32 1/2 W 90 poles thence S 30 1/2 W 24 poles
to a Hickory thence S 39. N 6 poles to a lightwood stump standing on the left hand road a corner for said Sact.
James, William James, Rebecca Whitfield, and said Lewis Worrell thence along said William James
line at 46 1/2 W 24 poles thence at 55. W. 14 poles thence at 52 W 20 poles to a pine a corner for Thomas
Newson in said William James line thence along said Thomas Newsons line at 43 1/2 E 45 poles to
first oak stump a corner for Sact. Jordan in said Nancy Newsons line thence along said Sact. Jordans line
at 62 E 19 1/2 poles to a first oak standing near the head of a small branch, thence down the various
courses of the run of said branch to a black oak corner for said Thomas Worrell in said Sact. Jordans
line thence along said Thomas James' line S 28 E. 76 poles thence S 46 1/2 E 76 poles to the first station
together with all rights, title interest, claim or demand of in and to the above described tracts or pa-
rcels of land and premises with their appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining; and
and to hold the aforesaid tracts or parcels of land and premises, with their appurtenances thereto be-
longing or in any way appertaining - To have and to hold the aforesaid tracts or parcels of
land and premises with all and singular their appurtenances thereto belonging as aforesaid
unto him the said Lewis Worrell and his heirs and assigns forever and the said Thomas James for his heirs and assigns forever
and with the said Lewis Worrell his heirs and assigns forever and the said Lewis Worrell his heirs
and assigns forever and for ever defend the right and title of the aforesaid two tracts of
land
