This Indenture made this 27th day of September one thousand eight hundred and thirty one
 Between Anthony Andrews of the one part and Albert Andrews of the other part all of the County of South-
 ampton and State of Virginia Witnesses that for and in Consideration of the sum of thirty dollars to
 him the said Anthony Andrews in hand paid or otherwise secured to be paid before the sealing of
 this my of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Anthony Andrews
 granted bargained and sold, and by these presents go out bargain sell enjoin and Confirm
 unto the said Albert Andrews and to his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of land
 lying and being in the County of Southampton and being a part of the tract or parcel of land
 whereon the said Anthony Andrews now resides and hereinafter in the following manner
 Beginning at the fork of road hole branch just below the old mill dam, thence up said branch to
 a small black oak branch that leads from the long pond to road hole branch thence down said branch
 to the beginning containing by estimation fifty acres be the same more or less To have and to hold
 the said tract or parcel of land to the said Albert Andrews and to his heirs and assigns to their
 proper use and behoof forever and the said Anthony Andrews do further covenant to and with
 the said Albert Andrews that this present deed of bargain and sale shall be unto him the said
 Albert Andrews and to his heirs and assigns forever a good and sufficient Warranty against
 him the said Anthony Andrews his heirs and assigns as well as against the right title claim
 and demand of all and every other person or persons claiming by through or under him In
 Witness whereof the said Anthony Andrews have hereunto set his hand and seal the day

This Indenture made this 3rd day of November 1831 Between Mills E. Lawrence and William Johnson
 of the first part and Lazara Johnson of the second part Whereas the said Lazara Johnson on the 26th
 day of March 1830 in Order to secure the said William Johnson for the sum of two hundred dollars
 due by Bond bearing date the 26th day of March 1830 executed to Mills E. Lawrence as Endorser to
 secure the same on the following property one tract of land containing One hundred and forty acres and
 whereas since the executing and delivery of the said Debt of Bond the said Lazara Johnson
 hath fully satisfied & paid the debt for which the said Bond was executed: Now This In-
 denture Witnesseth that for the consideration aforesaid and by the direction and Consent of
 the said Wm Lawrence party to these presents and the said Mills E. Lawrence having
 bargained and sold (remised released and Confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain
 sell remise release and Confirm unto the said Lazara Johnson all the estate right title
 interest claim and demand both at Law and Equity which the said Mills E. Lawrence
 hold in the land above described To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land
 to the said Lazara Johnson his heirs and assigns forever to the only part
 of him the said Lazara Johnson his heirs and assigns forever and the said
