Drew the receipt whereof the said Hamilton Esq. and singly his wife do hereby acknowledge themselves fully satisfied for one hundred and sixty acres of land be the same more or less situated lying and being in the County of Richmond and bounded as follows to wit on the east by the great Branch dam to sea creek on the South by sea creek on the West by the land of the said Richard Hart and Benjamin Hart's land up to John P. Pleasant's line and on the North by the land of the said John P. Pleasant to the said great Branch. And also all trees woods improvements, commons, profits, commodities, advowsons, emblements and hereditaments, what so ever to the said tract or parcel of land above mentioned belonging or in any way appertaining and also the reversion and reversions remainders and remainders rents and services of the said premises and of every part thereof and also all the estate right title interest claims and demand whatsoever of them the said Hamilton Esq. and singly his wife of in and to the said premises and every part thereof To have and to hold the said tract of land with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular other the premises heretofore mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of them rights onibus and appurtenant unto the said Benjamin L.
