This Indenture made this 21st day of March one thousand Eighty three and thirty one between Charlotte Travis of Southampton County of the one part and Edwin Travis of the same County of the other part, Witnesses that the said Charlotte Travis for and in consideration of the sum of Six dollars to her in hand paid by the said Edwin Travis the receipt whereof the said Charlotte Travis doth hereby acknowledging doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Edwin Travis his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land containing six acres be the same more or less situated lying and being in the County of Southampton beginning at a point in the middle North line thence along said North line to the long branch to a corner tree thence up a small branch nearly West to a corner in said branch thence nearly north a line of new marked trees to a corner thence a line of new marked trees to the beginning, containing six acres be the same more or less also all the wood, underwood, Commons, Common of pasture profit, Common, advantages, involvements and hereditaments, whatsover to the said tract or parcel of land above mentioned belonging or in any wise appertaining or in or upon the land growing happening or arising and also the reversion or reversions, remainders and remainders rents and services of the said premises of every part and parcel thereof and also all the estate right title interest claim and demand, whatsover of this the said Charlotte Travis and of in and to the said premises and every part thereof To have and to hold all and singular the said premises and every part thereof every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto the said Edwin Travis his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Edwin Travis his heirs and assigns forever and the said Charlotte Travis for her and her heirs the said tract of land and every part thereof against herself her heirs and against all other persons and persons whatsoever to the said Edwin Travis his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents, In testimony whereof the said Charlotte Travis have hereunto set her hand and affixed her seal the day and year above written
